Call to Order

III. Approval of Agenda

IV. Old Business

i. Old Dominion Organic Packaging Plant

Jordan Brandon informed to the Board this particular project, he's been working on for three years, he has been farming and growing produce in Brunswick County for seven years. Mr. Brandon started out with tobacco farming and since the number of smokers started decreasing the business was shrinking. He decided to take on organic produce, whereas that was in demand. Mr. Brandon stated he wanted to get into the produce business and it seemed like organic was the easy way to get in as far as selling and at the time there wasn't a whole lot of competition. He put up a packing plant on his farm big enough for him, but when he started bringing other famer into it, there was not enough capacity to get the produce through the facility. In conversation with his current buyers Parker Farms and Hollar & Greene.

Mr. Brandon stated the reason for this facility is because with the number of farmers he is currently partnered with, he doesn't have to capacity to hold all the produce from seven different farmers. The farmers do not have a nearby facility to bring the produce in, to make sure it packed at a commercial standard. The farmers need a centralized facility to bring their produce in, pack, sort and ship. Basically farmers need a centralized facility with storage and cooling to able to sell what the farmers in the area can grow properly.

Mr. Brandon mentioned to the Board, as far as funding, the project is about \$2 Million to finish the building. He is working with Mrs. Ann Taylor Wright to secure a loan through the Tobacco Commission as well has the IDA with a low interest loan. The partnership of farmers will be paying monthly with interest for the lease on the building being built by the IDA until the loan is satisfied. This project has received \$1 Million from Tobacco Commissions, \$435K from VDACS and \$2 Million from EDA in grants. The farmers are going to put \$5.2 Million in equipment.

Motion: Dr. Arthur Jarrett, Jr motioned, seconded by Dr. Arthur Jarrett, Jr. to approve an additional \$32,000 for Dewberry to continue the Architect & Engineering work at the I-85 Industrial Business Park. **Upon vote of those present motion was unanimously carried.**
